# **RSL News-George Town**

#### Update on Solar Panels installation.

#### **Background**

The solar panel project was facilitated to enable the George Town RSL Sub Branch to obtain a return from power generated via solar panels. The funding of this project was via both the State & Federal Governments. The Federal contribution was via a "community grant" which in our case was administered through Ross Hart MP the Federal Member for Bass. The State Grant was through the Treasurer the Hon Peter Gutwein. The contribution from both areas was in the vicinity of \$7800.



The project is to be implemented in two stages.

Phase 1 – purchase of panels and installation.

Phase 2 - Purchase of 2 x 9.1 kw reverse cycle air conditioners and two circular fans to assist in distributing the air flow in the "well-being" area.

#### **Current status.**

The funding from the Federal Government has been received and the installation of the panels (some 20 odd) and invertor has occurred. The appropriate paperwork with Tas. Networking has occurred.

We eagerly await the remaining grant from the State Government so we can get Phase 2 underway especially with the warm weather we have been receiving of late.

We are extremely grateful to both the Federal and State Governments in providing the grants. The Federal Governments grant had a 50% contribution by the RSL Sub Branch. That 50% was met by the State Government contribution. Subsequently the total project was at nil cost to the RSL Sub Branch.

Tasmanian Electrical Services (Denis Williams) have been also supportive in picking up any associated costs related to permits etc. This has again been similarly appreciated. Without the support we receive from local commercial entities and our volunteers, our Sub Branch would like it had to exist.

## **RSL Membership New By-Law amendment**

At the last RSL National Board meeting, held in November, the eligibility criteria for membership of the RSL was amended, and the RSL National By- Law 2 was amended as follows:

By-Law 2.3.1 (C) amended to read -

(C) The person is or was a member of the Australian Defence Force with a least one day's service (fulltime equivalent)".

Previously there was a qualifying period of six months this is no longer the case. The applicant need only have served one day in uniform to be eligible to be a member of the League.
