Do you know, you may be eligible to purchase a car or car parts free of goods and services tax?

Who is Eligible? Gold card, TPI or EDA under VEA or SRDP under MRCA.

Vehicles must be your personal transport, you must keep the vehicle for 8 years or 40,000Klms to be eligible to re-apply. Parts for repair of vehicle used for personal transport can also be claimed. If you need assistance with forms for such claims or need help to complete forms, please call into the Sub Branch and ask for Greg.
