Remembrance Day Thursday 11th November

The Sub Branch held the Remembrance Day Service at Max Harris Memorial Reserve yesterday. This service was well attended by the community, and we especially thank Port Dalrymple, Star of the Sea College and South George Town Primary Schools representation by staff and student attendance. We thank our Mayor Greg Keiser as well as our guest speak and Patron, Dr Tim Mooney who spoke with passion of the huge toll war pays both in the past and present, on communities and families.
